

WHPA Privacy Policy

World Health Professions Alliance (WHPA) is committed to safeguarding your privacy. We believe that the best way to protect the privacy of users of the WHPA website is to tell you what information we gather and ensure that you understand and consent to WHPA's uses of the information you provide.

We may occasionally modify this Privacy Policy – you can find the 'Last revision date' at the bottom of the page to know when it was last changed. Updates to the revised Privacy Policy will be published on this page so that you are always aware of what information we collect, how we use it and under what circumstances we use or disclose it. We may let you know via the homepage when this happens but you should check the policy regularly for any changes.

The Information We Collect

We use technology which allows us to anonymously track visitors to our website. This helps us to understand how you and other visitors use the information provided, which then allows us to improve our work to better suit our audience.

In running and maintaining our website, we may collect and process the following data:

- Anonymous user information about your use of the website, including details of your visits such as pages viewed, resources accessed, location of your visit, browser information. Such information includes traffic data, location data and other communication data.
- Information provided voluntarily by you. For example, when you register for the WHPA newsletter, we'll ask you to provide personal information such as your name and email address.
- Information that you provide when you communicate with us by any means.

Security

We are committed to using our best efforts to maintain the security of your personal information. WHPA employs a range of technologies and security measures to protect the information maintained on our systems from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, alteration, or destruction, and we regularly update our platforms with the mandatory security updates. Although we use our best efforts to protect the security of your personal information and our system, due to the inherently open nature of the Internet, no transmission via the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result of this and other factors beyond our control, we cannot guarantee the security of the information that you transmit to or through our website. Therefore, you assume that risk by using the website.

How Long your Data is Kept

WHPA only keeps the data for the time required for the pursuance of the above objectives. You can unsubscribe at any time from services to which you have subscribed.

Do We Share the Information we Receive?

Save as described in this policy, we do not otherwise disclose information about your individual visits to our websites or information which identifies you to any third parties unless we have your prior consent or unless requested by local regulators and law enforcement officers or required by applicable law, rule or regulation. However, in order to provide an efficient service, certain functions such as hosting, storage fulfilment and disaster recovery are provided by third parties. Where this is the case we will ask those with whom we share data to agree to protect data as WHPA has agreed in this Privacy Policy.

Worldwide Transfer of Your Data

The dynamics of the Internet may mean that information is sent electronically outside of the country where you originally entered the information. In addition, that information may be used, stored and



processed outside the country where you entered that information. While there is a risk that countries to which information is transferred will not be subject to an information protection regime as rigorous as that of the EEA, we will take reasonable steps to ensure that your information is treated securely and adequately protected in accordance with this Privacy Policy. However, if you are resident in the EEA and you do not want your information to be transferred outside of the EEA please do not send us personal data.

Cookies, What About 'Cookies'?
